*Jesus: The Lord (John 21:1-19)*

Our celebration of the Triduum—Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter—invites us to reflect on the Paschal Mystery: the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. The more we experience him—in scripture, sacrament and prayer—the deeper we come to understand and live that mystery. In this retreat, we will encounter Jesus through several very different people: the woman at the well; the man born blind; Martha and Mary, the sisters of Lazarus; and Peter. In doing so, we will also encounter ourselves and discover the ways in which we be ministers of reconciliation in a world of conflict, tellers of truth in a world of illusion, ministers of hope in a world of despair, and servants of Jesus in spite of our sins.

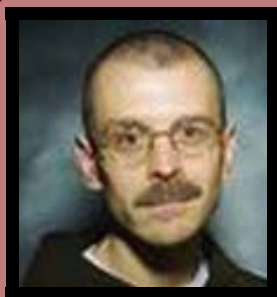
